

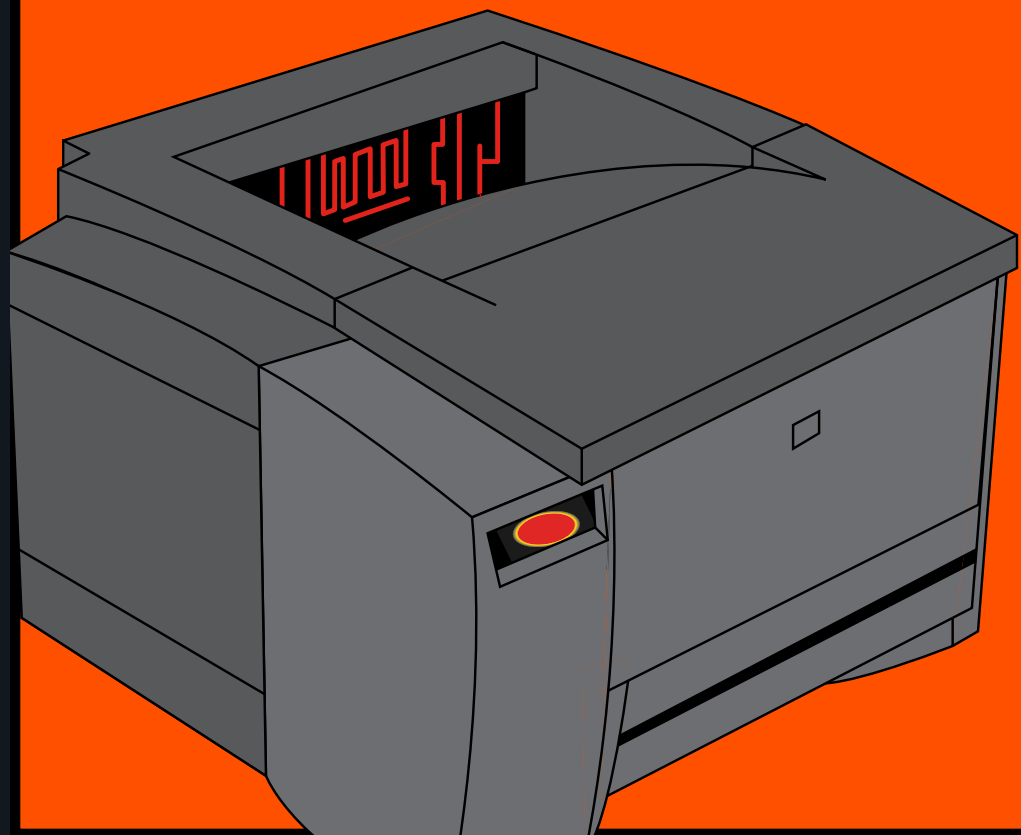

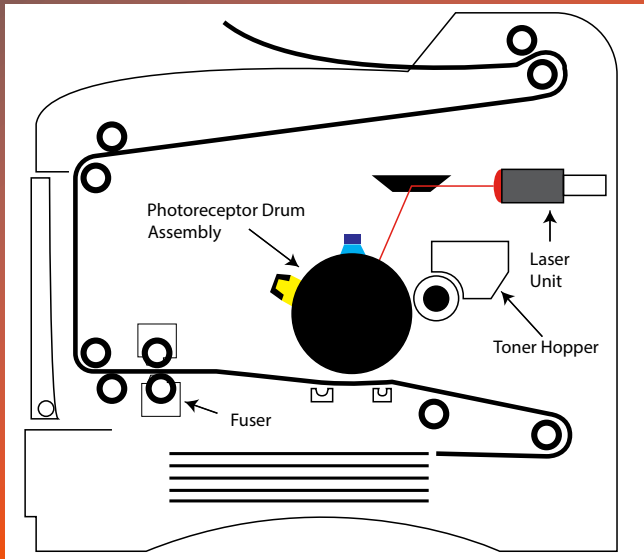

FASTER, CLEARER TEXT WITH

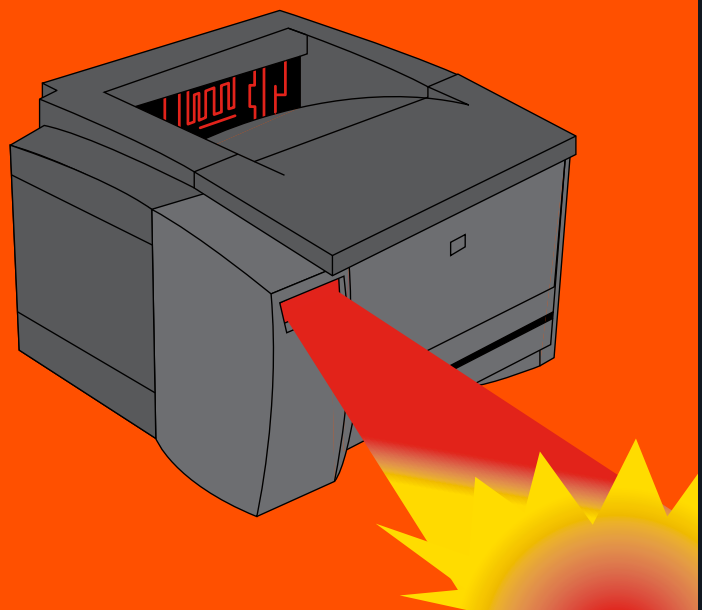
LESS TIME AND RESOURCES.

INNER WORKINGS

BY USING ITS BUILT IN LAZER BEAM, LAZER PRINTERS SCAN THE IMAGE ONTO A DRUM, BUILDING ELECTRICITY AND FORMING A PATTERN THAT ATTRACTS A POWERED INK CALLED TONER TRANSFERS IT UNTO THE SUBSTRATE.

CONS

HAS A LENGTHY WARM UP TIME, COSTS MORE AT THE START AND IS NO GOOD WITH SENSITIVE SUBSTRATE.

GREAT AGAINST DOCUMENTS WITH TONS OF IMAGERY, SMOOTHES COLORS TOGETHER BETTER.

CAN PRINT ON ALMOST ANY KIND OF

PAPER.

CONS

PRINTS SUSCEPTABLE TO WATER DAMAGE, SLOWER THEN LASER PRINTS, NOT CAPABLE OF LARGE PAPER LOADS



HOW IT DOES IT

THE MOST SEEN VERSION OF AN INKJET IS THE DROP ON DEMAND WHICH SQUIRTS DROPLETS OF INK FROM THE CARTRIDGE THROUGH TINY NOZZLES THAT TURN ON AND OFF AROUND 5,000 TIMES A SECOND
